

## **YouTube Video of the Month**

2026 is the centenary year for the Guillows Model Company, which was founded in 1926 by Paul K Guillow in Wakefield, Massachusetts. To celebrate this amazing achievement the Flying Aces Club, (FAC), in the USA are holding a Guillows free flight flying scale model mass launch competition at their own Nationals event later in the year. Models must be built using the supplied kit wood, which can be lightly sanded, and the modellers can supply their own rubber to power the model.

Master modeller Tom Hallman has recently posted a video on his YouTube channel, Maxiflair, which demonstrates him building his Grumman F6F Hellcat from a die cut Guillows kit in which he shares some of his methods to improve the flight performance of his model. It is well worth watching!
