## Sunshine, Scale Models & Soaring Success at Buckminster!

After a foggy start, the sun broke through to deliver near-perfect flying conditions for the final outdoor Scale Free Flight competition of 2025, held at the BMFA National Visitor Centre, Buckminster. With summer's unpredictable weather cancelling several events, this showdown was more than just a season finale—it was a battle for some coveted trophies!



### **Trophies Up for Grabs:**

- Aeromodeller & Model Aircraft Designs Print for the top-scoring model built from a published plan.
- Free Flight Kit Scale Print awarded to the best kit-built model in a nominated Scale-only event.

This year marked a milestone with the introduction of the new FF2 Scale Free Flight rules, allowing rubber, electric, and IC-powered models to compete side-by-side. Each model had a pre-flight assessment for realism and craftsmanship, with a maximum of 200 points up for grabs. Six competitors brought eight models to the field—the highest turnout in years—despite a few regulars unable to attend.

Models & Magic in the Air: From Gareth Tilston's compact Keil Kraft Piper Family Cruiser to Bill Dennis's majestic IC-powered Piper Super Cruiser, the diversity of designs was a treat for spectators and judges alike.

The informal flight format kept the skies buzzing, as competitors launched their models across four rounds whenever ready. The crisp October air at Buckminster proved ideal, with every entrant achieving at least one qualifying flight.



#### And the Winners Are...

- 1st Place: Gareth Tilston Keil Kraft Piper Family Cruiser (rubber powered). Gareth also claimed the Kit Scale Print.
- 2nd Place: Bill Dennis Keil Kraft Piper Super Cruiser (IC powered). Bill earned the Aeromodeller Print for his stunning Bristol Bullet, built from an Eddie Riding plan.
- **3rd Place**: *John Bowerman* Herr Design Fairchild Argus (rubber powered), with consistently strong flights.

Gareth's victory proves that small, well-built models can punch above their weight when the conditions are right!
