THE BOWDEN TROPHY. SUNDAY JUNE 4TH North Luffenham

This famous precision Free Flight Power event has moved to North Luffenham airfield and will be run on **Sunday June 4**th **at 10.30 am** PRIOR to the Free Flight Scale Nats and alongside the Free Flight Mini-Nats event

BASIC RULES (See also BMFA Rulebook)

OBJECT OF EVENT:

For model to fly to an exact target time (typically 45 secs)

For maximum points the model should Rise Off Ground.

Hand launches are acceptable but with a penalty.

Points are deducted for every second above and below the target time.

Points are also deducted for a poor flight pattern (eg stalling)

Flights over 60 sec and below 30 secs score 100 penalty points.

Scored over two rounds (scores from both rounds count)

OTHER RULES

Model must have a proper defined cockpit with forward visibility for the notional pilot. Entrants to the FF Scale event, why not enter the Bowden while your model is being Static Judged?

Entry to the airfield is via:-

This covers unlimited competition entries so entry to the Bowden is free!
